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ПРИМЕР ПИСЬМЕННОЙ ЧАСТИ:

These days, the majority of university students work part-time in addition to studying. There are both advantages and disadvantages to taking up part-time jobs as a university student, and in this comment, we will be taking a look at them.

Firstly, the main advantage of having a part-time job is more financial stability. Everybody knows how low can a monthly stipend get, so having an additional source of income is quite beneficial. Another advantage to being a student part-timer is the fact that it provides a good grounding in other spheres besides the one you are studying at university. This very grounding can be useful if, for some reason, a student fails to find a workplace suitable for their degree. Anecdotal evidence for my claims is that my cousin, with whom I talk a good lot, worked part-time at a fast-food chain while studying as a designer. This helped her both boost her income and develop important skills like time management.

Moving on to the disadvantages of working part-time as a university student, the first disadvantage is the fact that a part-time job can distract one from studying. This, in turn, can impede academic performance. Next, a part-time job can be quite exhausting for a university student, especially with the increased workload in universities compared to schools. As an effect of this, students might only focus on working and studying and forget about things like friends and family. One of my friends took up a part-time job while still in university, but quit after a while, as it was taking a toll on their academic performance and socialisation.

To conclude, there is an equal amount of advantages and disadvantages in working part-time as a university student, so certain circumstances that can tip the scales in favor of one option or another should be taken into account.

Анализ эссе

Абитуриент полностью владеет структурой эссе, все преимущества и недостатки проблемы проанализированы, а также приведены примеры (*Anecdotal evidence for my claims is that my cousin, with whom I talk a good lot*), помогающие раскрыть аргументы; заключение автора логично следует из основной части эссе. По критерию “Содержание” данная работа получает 5 баллов.

Проанализируем работу далее по критерию “Организация текста”: абитуриент использует разнообразные средства логической связи и, в отличие от автора первого эссе, делает это не механически; хотелось бы отметить, что в работе средства логической связи органично интегрированы в рассуждения, видно, что они используются автором для организации высказывания, то есть для перехода от одного пункта к другому (*Anecdotal evidence for my claims is that my cousin, with whom I talk a good lot; Moving on to the disadvantages; This, in turn...*). **В этом заключается основное отличие механического использования (это,**



как правило, вариации из набора “*firstly*”, “*secondly*”, “*moreover*”, “*furthermore*”, “*besides*”, “*in conclusion*”) средств логической связи от естественного. Структура эссе соответствует заданной, текст верно разделен на абзацы. Таким образом, данная работа получает 5 баллов по критерию “Организация текста”.

Абитуриент широко и верно использует лексический материал, соответствующий уровню C1-C1+ (*anecdotal evidence; provide good grounding; impede academic performance; increased workload; taking a toll on; tip the scales in favour of one option or another*), а также использует грамматический материал высокого уровня (разнообразные *relative clauses (with whom i talk a lot; as it was taking a toll...;)*). Мы не видим широкое использование грамматических структур уровня C1-C1+ (примерный список см.), однако лексический материал, чистота языка и ясность изложения говорят о широком активном языковом запасе и развитых письменных навыков, поэтому мы не считаем, что этот недостаток критичен при оценке работы. Абитуриент совершает немногочисленные языковые ошибки (например, порядок слов в “*Everybody knows how low can a monthly stipend get*”) в грамматическом материале более высокого уровня (мы можем предположить, что автор пытался использовать одну из *emphatic structures*). Соответственно, данная работа получает 4 балла по критерию “Языковое оформление” (но она крайне близка к 5 баллам).

Таким образом, данное эссе получает 14 баллов из 15; оно является образцовым и позволило бы абитуриенту попасть как в 10 класс, так и 11 (но для абитуриентов 11-го класса мы все же рекомендуем более обширное использование грамматических конструкций уровня C1-C1+).
